- Town & Country School was founded in 1961. More than 50 years of serving students with learning disabilities.
- We are the only state accredited, private, non-profit school in Oklahoma exclusively for children with learning disabilities in grades 1-12.
- Certified teachers with special education focus, 1 teacher and 1 assistant in each classroom, 1 clinical psychologist, 3 speech therapists, 2 certified educational tutors and 1 licensed counselor.
- All students receive Woodcock Johnson IV Test of Achievement, as well as, STAR Reading and Math, and speech and language evaluations.
- We offer art, physical education, music, and computers.
- Extracurricular activities include: boys' and girls' basketball, drama, karate, Legos, bowling, chess, running club, soccer club, book club, cheerleading, National Honor Society, yearbook.
- Technology: iPads, Smartboards, Audio Enhancement Systems and computers in every classroom, as well as Kindles and Alpha Smarts.
- Emotional Regulation techniques, social skills, speech and language therapy, and intensive reading skills are taught.
- We offer many specialized reading programs, including Lindamood-Bell, Orton-Gillingham and Wilson, among others. In addition, our handwriting curriculum also includes cursive.
- Sensory accommodations include: audio enhancement, noise canceling headphones, ball chairs, stand-up desks, pedal desks, fidgets, stress balls, quiet spaces, and more
- Our high school students may choose an educational path which can include Transitional Careers, Tulsa Technology Center, concurrent enrollment, and core/college prep curricula.
- Since 2000, we have graduated more than 200 students with a 100% graduation rate. Following graduation, 80% of our alumni go on to higher education, 18% enter the workforce, 2% serve in the armed forces.
